

Olde Raleigh Pool Rules

Outdoor Pool Opening May 27th

Closing date to be announced at a later date due to construction on the clubhouse.

Doors to be removed from the indoor pool area at by first of June.

By order of the Wake County Health Department the following rules must be followed by all members and guests. If a violation is cited, it may cause the pool to close.

1. **GLASS CONTAINERS** of any kind are **PROHIBITED IN THE POOL OR DECK AREAS!** (Glass breakage may cause the pool to be closed for an extended period of time.)
2. **THE GATE TO THE POOL AREA MUST REMAIN CLOSED AT ALL TIMES.** Do not prop the gate open in any way! This violates a health regulation in Wake County and poses a real danger to our young residents. This also applies to pool parties.
3. **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES.**
4. Training pants with snug fitting rubber pants or swim diapers are required for any infant/child not toilet trained. *Fecal contamination will cause the pool to close while water treatment is conducted.*

The following RULES AND REGULATIONS are for the protection of the homeowners in the community and to help assure that every family in Olde Raleigh enjoys the pool season:

1. **Pool Hours are from 6:00am-8:30pm.**
2. Please use the pool at your own risk; we do not have a lifeguard on duty at any time.
3. **Children under the age of 16, must be accompanied by a parent or other adult. The accompanying adult must be 18 years of age or older.**
4. Proper swim attire is required at all times. This means bathing suits only, no cut-offs, street clothes, or underwear.
5. All family members of homeowners may use the pool at any time. Guests of members will be allowed at no charge. Members must accompany their guests and adept full responsibility for them.
6. In order to respond to suggestions from the “older set,” it was agreed that ten minute adult swim periods would be observed, on the hour.
7. Please clean up your area when leaving the pool area and discard trash in appropriate containers and close the umbrellas to avoid wind damage.
8. Smoking is not permitted in the indoor pool area or inside the building.
9. The following items will not be allowed inside the pool area:
 - Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, rollerblades, etc.
 - Pets
 - Large floats, floating chairs.
 - Large balls or playing devices.
 - Glass objects of any kind.
10. Pool parties may be scheduled by contacting PPM prior to the event. The outdoor pool may not be used after 8:30pm, music must end by 11:00pm and the event must be concluded by 11:00 pm. Homeowners may not have exclusive use of the pool facilities.

Failure to comply with the rules may result in revocation of pool privileges.
